

SANITATION COMMITTEE MEETING
Wednesday, September 13, 2017
4:15 pm.

Absent: None.

The Committee reviewed the request from the owner of property at 303 McKinley street for a sewer credit. The owner accidently left their outside hose on for two days. The Committee approved a onetime credit using a three-month average.

Rick brought a request from property owner at 802 E. Monroe for help in the cost of fixing her sewer where it connects with the sewer main. Jim Warner reported that this was a spot repair programed to be fixed by the City. The Committee recommended paying Kevin owner of Christensen Construction \$3,600.00 for the repair.

Rick brought a request from Pleasant View Mennonite Church to help pay for repairs they had to make on their sanitary sewer. The Committee declined the request since this was their lateral problem not City sewer maintenance.

The Committee reviewed quotes for new heaters at the WWTP main building. The Committee recommended the purchase from Jason Smith Plumbing for approximately \$7,700. The Committee directed staff to file an insurance claim because this was caused by fire.

Brent informed the Committee there is a potential residential development that might occur on South Linden Drive. The Committee discussed two ways to get Sanitary Sewer to the proposed development.

Jim informed the Committee that he is working with IDNR to get approval for the spot repair and lining project.

Jim informed the Committee that he is waiting on the IDNR for approval for the Jay Street projects.

Brent shared a letter sent to Contitech on how the City will be billing them for their sanitary sewer flow fee.

Brent reviewed the proposal from WEMIGA to provide private solid waste collection service for the City. The Committee reviewed the proposal and recommended to not privatize.

Brent informed the Committee that Jim Warner will be providing the City a proposal to evaluate the proposed new flood plain areas the IDNR is proposing for the City of Mount Pleasant.
