The Mount Pleasant City Council met in regular session Wednesday, March 8, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. in City Hall. The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and the roll being called there were present Steven K. Brimhall in the Chair and the following named Councilmembers-

It was moved by Councilmember Engberg and seconded by Councilmember White that the Council approve the following consent agenda items with one roll call motion.

Councilmember Crull moved and was seconded by Councilmember Savage that the Council approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilmember Crull and seconded by Councilmember Engberg that the following entitled ordinance be read for the third time, be adopted, and assigned No.1325:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-4, ENTITLED "SPEED LIMITS" TO CHANGE SPEED LIMIT IN THE SCHOOL ZONE NEAR THE FORMER HIGH SCHOOL FROM TWENTY MILES PER HOUR TO TWENTY-FIVE MILES PER HOUR

Roll call vote 6-0. Motion carried.

Councilmember Crull moved and was seconded by Councilmember McWilliams that the following entitled ordinance be read for the second time

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20 SEWERS AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL, SECTION 20-4 ENTITLED "CONNECTION TO SYSTEM REQUIRED", AND CHAPTER 25 MUNICIPAL FEES AND CHARGES, SECTION 25-4 ENTITLED "PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM PERMIT FEES" OF THE MOUNT PLEASANT MUNICIPAL CODE

Roll call 6-0. Motion carried.

Councilmember McWilliams moved and was seconded by Councilmember Savage that the Council approve the re-appointment of Justin Lange to a three-year term on the Construction Appeals Board. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilmember Crull and seconded by Councilmember White that the Council approve an amended Engineering Services Agreement with Warner Engineering for the Sewer Improvements Project Area No. 2 North for an increased cost of \$72,000. Motion carried.

Councilmember Crull moved and was seconded by Councilmember Engberg that the Council approve an amended Engineering Services Agreement with Warner Engineering for the Sewer Improvements Area No. 2 and 3 South project for an increased cost of \$72,000. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilmember Crull and seconded by Councilmember White that the Council approve an amended Engineering Services Agreement with Shive Hattery for the Heather Branch Bar Screen Replacement project that will increase the contract by \$37,000. Motion carried.

Councilmember McWilliams moved and was seconded by Councilmember Engberg that the Council approve the request of Main Street Mount Pleasant to serve alcohol in Central Park on May 30th 2017 for their Wings in Spring event. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilmembers Crull and seconded by Councilmember Huisinga that the Council approve an Encroachment Permit for Lincoln school to extend a fence that is on the City street right of way at 501 Corkhill. Motion carried.

Councilmember Savage moved and was seconded by Councilmember Engberg that the Council approve an Encroachment Permit for Scott Lowe to construction fire escape stairs in the City right of way in the alley behind 103 South Jefferson Street. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilmember Crull and seconded by Councilmember Engberg that the Council adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 4:12 p.m.
