The Mount Pleasant City Council met in regular session at 307 E. Monroe Street, City Hall second floor meeting room Wednesday, September 28, 2016, at 5:30 p.m. The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and the roll being called there were present Steven K. Brimhall in the Chair and the following named Councilmembers-

It was moved by Councilmember Crull and seconded by Councilmember White that the Council approve the following consent agenda items with one roll call motion.

the report of officers including the following inter-fund transfers for September; \$25,010 from General Fund to Library General Fund; 76,000 from Sewer Revenue Fund to Sewer Operation & Maint Fund; \$91,790 from Sewer Revenue Fund to Sewer Sinking Fund; \$1,600 from IPAIT Sales Tax Fund to US Bank Capital Projects Fund (Business Park sidewalks); \$31,528 from US Bank Capital Projects Fund to IPAIT Sales Tax Fund (refund correction to June Airport Lighting transfer); \$24,173.06 from IPAIT Sales Tax Fund to US Bank Capital Projects Fund (West Green Street project); \$10,587.98 from IPAIT Sales Tax Fund to US Bank Capital Projects Fund (East Langdon project);  
the renewal application for a Class E Liquor License, Class C Beer Permit & Class B Wine Permit for T&L's Pep Stop at 901 East Washington,  
the application for a Use of Outdoor Amplified Sound System Permit for Iowa Wesleyan University at 601 North Main Street on September 30, 2016 and October 1, 2016.
