9. Pursuant to the Underground Facilities Information Act (Iowa Code, Chapter 480), all excavations shall comply with Iowa One Call installation / excavation guidelines. As part of this process, all new construction shall be installed in a manner which does not unnecessarily interfere with existing utility infrastructure already located within the city right-of-way. Additionally, to accommodate future maintenance needs, no new underground installations shall be installed within a 24 inch radius (including directly above or below) an existing underground facility without prior approval.
10. Upon completion of any underground excavation, all property which was impacted by the excavation shall be restored to its original condition prior to the project. This will include any necessary grading, addition of top soil and reseeding.
11. Pursuant Iowa Code, Chapter 355, all survey monuments (and "pins") must be preserved. The excavator must comply with all provisions of Iowa Code, Chapter 355, and other applicable provisions of local, state, and federal regulations. All survey monuments that are disturbed must be replaced by a licensed surveyor in accordance with Iowa Code Chapter 355. The City of Mount Pleasant and any other government authority with jurisdiction reserves the right to require that all monuments that are likely to be disturbed to be identified in accordance with Iowa Code, Chapter 355, before this permit is granted and before excavation begins.
