For purposes of temporary signs, the right-of-way is considered to be the property which is between the curb and the sidewalk. If there is no sidewalk, the right-of-way is the property that is within six (6) feet of the curb. Promotional (temporary) signs are regulated by Section 19.09.110 of the City Zoning Ordinance. Additional information may be required as determined by the Building and Zoning Administrator.
