

**City of Mt. Pleasant**  
**Sidewalk Replacement Program for Reimbursement to the Property Owner**  
**Fiscal Year 2019-2020**

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Pleasant is a municipal corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of Iowa, and

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Pleasant has allocated money in the fiscal year 2019-2020 budget for sidewalk replacement, and

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Pleasant desires to reimburse a portion of the cost incurred by property owners for replacement of existing sidewalks within the City limits of Mt. Pleasant, so long as allocated funds are available, and

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Pleasant desires that the reimbursement to the property owner be in an amount of up to 4 yards of type 4000 mix concrete and up to \$75.00 of rebar upon submission and approval of receipts.

NOW, THEREFORE, I BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF MT. PLEASANT:

That the following rules be adopted and designated as the City of Mt. Pleasant sidewalk Replacement Program for the Fiscal year 2019-2020.

1. Property owners must first apply for a sidewalk permit at the Public Works Department in Mt. Pleasant, Iowa. The permit shall be submitted to the Public Works Director for approval. If the application is approved, a permit shall be issued at no cost to the applicant.
2. The sidewalk shall be constructed to meet the specifications as set forth in the attached guidelines.
3. The property owner must notify the Public Works Director upon completion of the sidewalk improvement for final inspection to be performed by the Public Works Director, or his designee. Upon approval of said work, reimbursement shall be issued at City Hall at a rate up to 4 yards of concrete and up to \$75.00 of rebar, so long as allocated funds remain.
