

Mount Pleasant, Iowa, August 27, 2025

The Mount Pleasant City Council met in regular session on Wednesday, August 27, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall, 307 East Monroe Street, second-floor meeting room. The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and the roll being called there were present Steven K. Brimhall in the Chair and the following named Councilmembers.

It was moved by Councilmember White and seconded by Councilmember Griffith that the Council approve the following consent agenda items with one roll call motion vote:

the minutes of the August 13, 2025, City Council Meeting;

the payment of bills totaling \$109,086.41;

the Renewal of a Class B Retail Alcohol License for Pilot Travel Centers LLC located at 1300 North Grand Avenue;

the Outdoor Amplified Sound Permit for Sigma at TTT Shelter in Saunders Park for September 20, 2025 from 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.;

the request from the Optimist Club to close Monroe Street from Jefferson Street to Main Street on September 7, 2025 from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for their annual Patriot and Family Day.

Roll call vote 4-0. Motion carried.

Councilmember Griffith moved and Councilmember Engberg seconded that the Council approve the Proclamation Celebrating Southeast Iowa Symphony Orchestra's 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Motion carried, 4-0.

Councilmember Griffith moved and Councilmember Glaha seconded that the Council approve the agenda as printed.

Roll call vote 4-0. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilmember Glaha and seconded by Councilmember White that the Council read for the second time the following ordinance:

Roll call vote 4-0.

Councilmember White moved and Councilmember Glaha seconded that the Council approve the FYE25 Road Use Tax Report. Motion carried, 4-0.

Councilmember Engberg moved and Councilmember Glaha seconded the motion to table approving and authorizing the Mayor to sign a contract for the removal of asbestos-containing materials at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Baptist Church. Motion carried, 4-0.

Kacey Conrad of 203 South Wilson Street spoke to the Council to share her concerns about the motorcycle incident at the courthouse.

Councilmember Engberg moved and Councilmember Glaha seconded that the Council adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:43 p.m. to meet in regular session Wednesday, September 10, 2025, at 5:30 p.m.
