

Mount Pleasant, Iowa, September 24, 2025

The Mount Pleasant City Council met in regular session on Wednesday, September 24, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall, 307 East Monroe Street, second-floor meeting room. The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and the roll being called there were present Steven K. Brimhall in the Chair and the following named Councilmembers.

It was moved by Councilmember Griffith and seconded by Councilmember White that the Council approve the following consent agenda items with one roll call motion vote:

the minutes of the September 10, 2025, City Council Meeting;
the payment of bills totaling \$127,105.85;
the report of officers;
the Outdoor Amplified Sound Permit for Main Street Mount Pleasant Pints in the Park Event in Central Park October 3, 2025, 5:30 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Roll call vote 5-0. Motion carried.

The Mayor read a Proclamation declaring October 2025 Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

Councilmember Griffith moved and Councilmember Glaha seconded that the Council approve the agenda as printed.

Roll call vote 5-0. Motion carried.

Councilmember Engberg moved and Councilmember White seconded that the Council reject the following entitled Resolution No. 2025-70:

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BID FOR ESTIMATED COSTS FOR THE 2ND BAPTIST CHURCH PROJECT

The bid for the project was higher than expected; the Historic Preservation Commission and Personnel and Finance Committee met previously and decided to reevaluate the project. Roll call vote 5-0, motion carried.

Councilmember Engberg moved and Councilmember White seconded the motion to reject the contract for the removal of asbestos-containing materials at the 2nd Baptist Church. Motion carried, 5-0.

It was moved by Councilmember McWilliams and seconded by Councilmember Griffith that the Council approve the bid from LL Pelling Co. of \$22,355.00 to asphalt the compost road and authorize the Mayor to sign the proposal. Motion carried, 5-0.

It was moved by Councilmember Engberg and seconded by Councilmember Glaha that the Council approve the bid from Sattler Concrete Construction for \$18,500.00 to repair the pool foundation. Motion carried, 5-0.

Councilmember McWilliams moved and Councilmember White seconded that the Council approve the following Mayoral appointments – Kurt Moon and Kirsten Herdt renewing three-year terms on the Community Development Committee and Mike Gardner renewing for a three-year term on the Airport Advisory Committee. Motion carried, 5-0.

Councilmember Glaha moved and Councilmember Engberg seconded that the Council adopt the following entitled Resolution No. 2025-74:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE IOWA TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET-ASIDE PROGRAM (TAP) FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE WASHINGTON-GRAND CONNECTOR TRAIL

Roll call vote 5-0. Resolution adopted, signed by the Mayor and hereby made a portion of these minutes.
