- 8a) This is the time set for the Public Hearing on the proposed FYE 2027 budget. The tax asking is \$11.94 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation. This is broken down by \$7.86 basic levy, \$0.96 employee benefit levy and \$3.12 debt service levy. The rate decreased from \$12.18 to \$11.94 per \$1,000.00 taxable value from the FYE 2026 Budget.
- 8b) This Resolution would approve the proposed FYE 2027 budget asking for FYE 2027 at \$11.94 per \$1,000.00 taxable value. The Personnel and Finance Committee has reviewed the budget and recommends approval.
- \*8c) Renewal of a Class F Retail Alcohol License for Loyal Order of Moose located at 108 North Saunders Avenue.
- \*8d) Renewal of a Class E Retail Alcohol License for Hy-Vee Food Store #1433 located at 1700 East Washington Street.

**New Business:**

- 9a) This motion would approve Change Order #4 for the airport taxi lane and hangar construction project. The Change Order was needed due to nighttime temperatures dipping below freezing. The Change Order will result in an increase of \$15,441.00.
- 9b) This motion will approve the appointment of Mike Tometich to a 6-year term on the Library Board replacing Paulette Shappell whose term expires July 1, 2026.
- 9c) This motion would approve setting the date for the Public Hearing for May 27, 2026 at 5:30 p.m. to amend the 2025/2026 Budget.

- 9f) This Resolution would approve the temporary and seasonal part-time employees' hourly wage for the FYE 2027. The Personnel and Finance Committee has reviewed and recommended approval.
- 9g) This Resolution would authorize the change of assignment of Nicholas A. Ettinger from Deputy Fire Chief to Fire Fighter with the Mount Pleasant Fire Department. The Fire Chief has approved the change of assignment.
