Review Quotes for Asphalt at the Cemetery

The Committee reviewed asphalt paving quotes submitted by Norris Asphalt for improvements at the cemetery and on a portion of Harrison Street. Public Works Director Drew Schumacher presented the proposals, including a map identifying the section of the cemetery scheduled for paving this year, as well as areas completed during previous years. Schumacher also presented a quote for paving Harrison Street from Monroe Street to Madison Street. Following discussion, the Committee approved both quotes and recommended forwarding them to the City Council for final consideration.

Second Baptist Church Transfer of Funds

The Committee heard a presentation from Jeff Thomas and Joy Lapp of the Historic Preservation Commission regarding the transfer of funds designated for the Second Baptist Church to a newly established nonprofit organization. The transfer would also allow the City to deed ownership of the church to the nonprofit, enabling the organization to pursue basement renovation and construction projects that are not feasible while the City retains ownership.

City Administrator Joe Taylor recommended approval of the transfer of both the funds and the property to the nonprofit organization. Following discussion, the Committee approved the request to transfer the funds and recommended forwarding the matter to the City Council for consideration at a future meeting.
