New Business:

- 9a) This motion would approve the resignation of Councilperson Kent White effective as of September 9, 2026. Kent is moving out of his elected Ward 1 and will be unable to fill the position.
- 9b) This motion would authorize the City Clerk to execute and sign the FYE26 Road Use Tax report. This is an annual report required by the state that contains FYE26 Road Use Tax expenses and revenues, equipment purchases, and the use of bond funds for street improvements.
- 9c) This motion would authorize the Mayor to sign an Engineering Services Agreement with JEO Consulting Group for the South Walnut Street over Heather Branch Creek Culvert Replacement Project. Staff recommends the Mayor execute the agreement with JEO Consulting Group for the design of the project. Calhoun-Burns & Associates, who had previously been considered for the project, requested to withdraw due to current workload constraints and concerns about their ability to provide the level of service and responsiveness needed to successfully deliver the project. JEO has the qualifications and capacity to complete the design work and keep the project moving forward in a timely manner.
- 9d) This Resolution would approve the promotion of Nathan L. Ensminger to the position of Lieutenant with the Mount Pleasant Police Department.
